

Marina Safety information

- Please ensure that the security gate closes behind you. Do not allow access to strangers. In the event of gate failure, contact the Marina Office during office hours. Out of hours, contact Security to arrange a call out. Tel: 01792 646640.
- Please do not store any items on the pontoons. Do not obstruct safety equipment and do not tie up to safety ladders.
- Refuse compounds are located close to each bridge-head. Recycling points for batteries, glass and waste oil are also located here.
- Please prevent dogs fouling the walkways. Dogs must be kept on leads whilst on the pontoons.
- Vessels must not discharge sewage or contaminated bilge water into the marina.
- In the event of an emergency dial 999 Emergency Services or call the Coastguard on Ch.16. Emergency Telephones are located at the Main Office and Tawe Lock.
- Re-fuelling must not take place on the pontoons, only on the designated fuelling berths. Barbecues must not take place on the pontoons.
- Sluice rooms for emptying chemical toilets are located in the Main Office and Phase II amenity block.
- Oil spills should be reported to the Marina immediately. Oil absorbent equipment is available at the Marina Office.
- Heavy maintenance must not be carried out without prior approval from the Marina Office. Noisy generators must not be run during hours of darkness.
- Electricity - to top-up your supply, please contact Reception.
- Life Jackets should be worn on pontoons in adverse weather conditions
- Children should wear lifejackets at all times.
- Swansea Marina will accept no liability for any loss or damage caused by any disruption to electrical supplies.




